In the process of writing our second book, “Early Virginia Colonial Families, the Crittendens, Downs Lees, Ludwells, Taylors and Collateral Families”, we learned that all these families are connected whether it be through family, neighbors, church, business or government matters. We became aware of a much broader group which encompassed these people. We never expected the ancestors of the Fosters of IZARD Co., AR, to be a part of early London/Virginia merchants. The following is a collection of records which pertain not only to Philip Foster, but those with which he had business dealings.

John Pope, servant to Tho. Taylor, relinquishes his corne & is declared free, & that Taylor forthwith pay him his clothes according to custom, als exec., Yorke Co., Bk. 6, p. 177, Jan. 26, 1679/80.

Phillip Foster of London, merchant, appoints Capt. Zacharick Taylor Commander of the ship Augustine now in a voyage to Va., my lawful attorney to receive accounts from Thos. Vicars, Benj. Buck, Wm. Howard, Sr., Ralph Green, Jr., & Elizabeth Vaulx of Va., 26 Sept. 1679; Rec. Yorke Co. Va. Court, 26 Jan. 1679/80, p. 183, Bk. 6.

Eliz. Vaulx, Jan. 26, 1679, petitions to next court to meet suit of Capt. Zack. Taylor & that of Tho. Ballard, Esq., Bk. 6, p. 189, Yorke Co.

Capt. Zack. Taylor awarded judgment against Eliz. Vaulx & others; Bk. 6, p. 196, Feb. 24, 1679/80, York Co.

Thomas Hudson of New Poquoson Parish, York Co., planter is possessed of 1079 acres land in New Poquoson Parish on assignment from Jono. Sheppard, original patentee 1st June 1645, now sells Christopher Garlington of New Poquoson Parish, York Co., the 1079 acres; signed Tho. Hudson. Test.: Robt. Bouth & R. Perry, dated 25 Jan., 1647, Rec. 24 July 1648 by Tho. Hudson & Robt. Bouth. Rec. Northumberland Co. Va., Feb. 24, 1679/80. Confirmed by Christopher Garlington, Sarah Darlington (his wife), Samuel Smith & Joan (X) Smith, Feb. 24, 1679/80, York Co., Bk. 6, p. 200.

Notice several Taylor names including mariners/merchants Zachary Taylor, Philip Foster, William Sherwood (attorney for both men), Elizabeth *Vaulx*, Thomas Taylor and Tho. Ballard, all familiar names in our book. This is a reminder that *Thomas Vaus/Vaulx* was granted land for transporting ten persons, including Philip Foster to Virginia.

Yorke Co. Va., Bk. 6, p. 281, Jan. 24, 1680/1-Daniel Taylor, Foreman of a Jury, Plaintiff fined 100 lbs. tobacco; signed Daniel Taylor, foreman.

October 1677. Thomas Elliott of London, mariner, age 30, deposes for Thomas Gardner, defendant to Phillip Foster, Zachary Taylor, and others, that in January last he was on the *Adam*, Commander Thomas Gardner, when they seized a sloop from the rebels in Virginia.
