This Indenture made this 20th day of April in the year of our Lord eight hundred and one between Samuel Meredith and Jane his wife of the one part and William Amsteead of the County of Amherst of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Samuel Meredith and Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to him the said Samuel in hand paid before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Samuel and Jane his wife have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said William Amsteead his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Amherst and bounded as follows Beginning at a stake in the race path in David Gyalands line opposite to a red oak sapling marked with three chops on the land of said Gyaland running thence north 83 W 20 poles to a stake in an old field thence S 7 E 26 poles to a smaller red oak sapling S 83 E 20 po to a stake in David Gyalands line and with it S 7 W 26 po to the first station containing by a late survey three and one quarter acres of land situate near the head of the race path on the ridge between the waters of Buzzards Ham Mill Creek and Airmans Creek the same being part of a larger tract belonging to Samuel Meredith party to these presents. To have to hold the said land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances unto him the said William Amsteead his heirs and assigns forever. And he the said Samuel Meredith doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said William Amsteead that he the said Samuel the above mentioned land and premises to the said William shall and will warrant and forever defend against the legal claims & demands of all and every person whatsoever. At a Court held for Amherst County the 20th day of April 1801 This Deed was proven by the oath of William Edmunds jr William Knight & David Gyaland Witnesses present and ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made and entered into this 30th day of October 1800 between John Ware jr of the County of Amherst of the one part and William Mauwicks of the County of Campbell of the other part

Witnesseth that he and in consideration of six shillings Virginia Currency the receipt whereof I do hereby fully acknowledge, but more especially to secure to said Mauwicks a debt due to him of one hundred and eighty one pounds twelve shillings & 6th current money of Virginia as by my note to him of the 19th July last and which he the said John Ware jr has by his desire to pay have granted bargained and sold delivered and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm to the said William Mauwicks one tract or parcel of land whereon some time containing one hundred acres more or less together with the following property Viz one negro man by the name of Charles one black mare and six head of Cattle with all the appurtenances belonging or in anywise appurtening to the land hereby granted or intended to be granted & the reversion or reversions and all the benefit and profit of the said Land and premises together with a good title to the said property to the said William Mauwicks his heirs & forever to his only proper use and behoof him the said Wm Mauwicks and his heirs forever. The said John Ware jr for himself this being the above described the premises together with the property named and described shall and will warrant & forever defend to the said William Mauwicks and his heirs forever against him the said John Ware jr his heirs & assigns against the claims or claims of any other person or persons whatsoever. Upon trust nevertheless that if the said John Ware jr shall once and lawfully pay or cause to be paid to the said Daniel Mauwicks the said sum of one hundred and eighty one pounds & twelve shillings and four pence current money of Virginia with interest thereon or before the first day of December next then and in that case the said William Mauwicks to convey to the said John Ware jr his heirs or assigns the above described land and property. In default of the said John Ware jr paying the said sum of one hundred and eighty one pounds & twelve shillings & four pence the said first day of December next then and in that case for the said William Mauwicks to sell and dispose of the said Land and premises to the highest bidder after having advertised the same for three weeks before the day of sale at Amherst Court house and such other public places as he the said William Mauwicks shall think proper & might the sale for ready money and for him the said William Mauwicks to convey to the purchaser a full and perfect good title in fee simple to the above described land & property & all of the money to be raised by the sale aforesaid to pay to the said Daniel Mauwicks the said sum of one hundred and eighty one pounds 12/4 w. int & 6th of the balance if any to the said John Ware jr. In witness whereof the said John Ware jr & William Mauwicks have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day and year above written.
