side of the main street, and adjoining the said Knight's improved Lot no 5, and to the south thereof being thirty five yards in front on the main street, and seventy yards deep, and bounded on the south by market street, also one Lot no 7 on the south side of the main street 35 yards in front and seventy yards deep bounded on the alley on the north. Beginning at pointers on the main road corner to Catharine Campbell's Lot of Land and running thence up the road Twenty five poles to pointers corner to the land
